SUPPLY LIST


I'M USING	YOU CAN SUBSTITUTE WITH
Oil paint paper 110 lbs, taped to board, 12x16 inch / 30x40 cm	Any paper 110 lbs and up or a watercolor paper block or mixed media journal page. You can also use a board, panel or canvas.
Acrylic paint in:	Use any consistency or brand you want.
- Burnt Sienna - Burnt Umber - Ultramarine Blue - Titanium White	You can replace Ultramarine Blue with Payne's Grey or Black
Brushes (synthetic): - 1 inch flat brush - Smaller soft, round brush - Course, cheap round brush	Any brush, as long as you have a bigger and a smaller one. Brush size also depends on your substrate size. Use whatever brush you comfortable with.
Acrylic medium matte A palette A rag/cloth Water	You can replace with acrylic glazing medium. Just make sure whatever you use is NOT gel medium. It needs to be fluid.
